Financial abuse is behaviour that seeks to control someone else's money. It can come in many forms. Here is a short list of signs to look out for.

CONTROLLING YOUR BANK ACCOUNT:

- Controlling how your money is spent
- Taking your benefits, pensions or income



TAKING DEBIT/CREDIT CARDS WITHOUT PERMISSION



RESTRICTING YOUR ACCESS TO A CAR OR PHONE



MAKING FINANCIAL DECISIONS WITHOUT YOUR CONSENT

- Taking out loans
- Selling your things
- Changing your will
- Buying things with your card



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BORROWING MONEY IN YOUR NAME

- This is called 'debt coercion'

- Opening your letters
- Accessing your online accounts

- Not letting you work
- Not letting you see family and friends
